FOREWORD

Across the region Yorkshire Forward's leading Urban Renaissance programme is working with local communities through "Town Teams", assembled to represent amenity, business and political interests. Together we are creating long term environmental, social and economic regeneration strategies for the region's towns and cities, built upon rising aspirations and enhanced skills in citizenship and civic leadership.

Halifax was one of the second group of towns in the region to be designated a 'renaissance town' by Yorkshire Forward following on from Huddersfield, Doncaster, Barnsley, Grimsby, Scarborough and Wakefield. In Halifax, as in all the first renaissance towns, an early and enthusiastic engagement with local political, business and community interests was established who worked closely with Yorkshire Forward's Urban Renaissance Panel. The Strategic Development Framework for Halifax has, throughout its development, generated debate across the town and beyond, both nationally and internationally. The resulting work, sometimes controversial and always challenging has now achieved a position of agreement and support so that the way forward has been identified, together with immediate opportunities for investment.

These are early days in the context of a thirty year framework that Halifax has established for the realisation of its dream. But the first and perhaps most important step has been taken: the town, and its civic leadership has a vision for the future of the town; a plan whose framework is long term without being inflexible; a plan capable of responding to future changing economic and social conditions; a plan fundamentally based upon delivering a high quality urban environment, amenable, accessible and attractive, and most importantly a plan by the people of Halifax for the people of Halifax.

WE BELIEVE THAT...

HALIFAX IS FULL OF REALLY GOOD THINGS BUT NOT ENOUGH PEOPLE KNOW ABOUT THEM. THEY WILL BE TOLD

THE JEWELS OF HALIFAX: THE PIECE HALL, THE PARISH CHURCH, EUREKA!, PEOPLE'S PARK, SOMERSET HOUSE, AND DEAN CLOUGH, MUST BE AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE TOWN CENTRE AND PROMOTED AS ITS UNIQUE ASSETS

THE PIECE HALL IS SO IMPORTANT TO THE HISTORY OF THE TOWN AND TO ITS FUTURE THAT THE HIGHEST PRIORITY MUST BE GIVEN TO SECURING A VIABLE AND SUSTAINABLE NEW ROLE

NEW HOMES MUST BE CREATED ACROSS THE TOWN CENTRE AND IT WILL BECOME A GOOD PLACE TO LIVE AS WELL AS TO SHOP AND TO WORK AND TO SPEND LEISURE TIME

THE GREEN SETTING OF THE TOWN CENTRE IS A UNIQUE CHARACTERISTIC AND MUST BE REDISCOVERED FOR THE BENEFIT OF HALIFAX'S CITIZENS AND ITS VISITORS
